The Boston Preservation Alliance is seeking nominations for its annual Preservation Achievement Awards. The 2012 Awards recognize exemplary preservation projects or activities that have been completed within 2011. Submissions are limited to properties and programs in Boston's neighborhoods and downtown area.

Winners of this year's Preservation Achievement Awards will be honored at the Alliance's 2012 Awards celebration to be held in October. **Nominations must be received by Friday, April 27, 2012.**

Suggested Award Nomination Categories

1. Notable new construction in harmony with Boston's built environment.
2. Significant rehabilitation/restoration preserving Boston's architectural or cultural heritage.
3. Significant public art contributing to Boston's urban fabric.
4. Notable examples of parks, landscapes, and natural areas that are new or have been preserved or restored.
5. Significant lighting and design in the harmony with Boston's built environment.
6. Significant neighborhood preservation efforts.
